I object to Sprint's discontinuance of wire line long distance service. I am on a fixed income and only need long distance on occasion. Sprint offers me long distance for \$3.50 a month with 55 free minutes. I have tried and cannot locate a similar plan. Most plans want \$10 and only offer 30 free minutes, and Verizon is the only service in my area. Since my state adopted the FCC regulation that mandates that I have long distance service or pay a penalty of \$5.00, the hardship of Sprint discontinuing this service is unfair and will create a hardship to me. I am sure there are many other seniors who are in the same situation as I find myself with this cancelling of long distance services by Sprint. Sprint has given me a shut-off date of September 19, 2015 for this service. They indicate that they will be granted this approval. I am requesting that you please consider the impact on this decision for people on fixed incomes and unable to get the same service for the same cost.
