MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY

KSQA L.L.C., licensee of television station KSQA, Channel 12, Topeka, Kansas, (“KSQA”) by its attorneys, pursuant to Section 1.46(c) of the Commission’s Rules, hereby moves for a brief extension of time to respond to the Answer filed July 23, 2015 by DirecTV, in response to the above-captioned Complaint for Carriage filed by KSQA.

The DirecTV Answer includes several exhibits that raise engineering and technical issues. KSQA needs to consult its technical consultants on these matters. Some of KSQA’s consultants, and undersigned counsel, have travel plans and business commitments that make it very difficult for KSQA to respond within the time allotted by the Commission’s Rules.

Pursuant to Section 76.7(c)(3) and Section 1.4(h) of the Commission’s Rules, the KSQA Reply would be due Thursday, August 6, 2015. KSQA requests a one week extension, until Thursday, August 13, 2015, to respond to the DirecTV Answer. The pleading cycle in this proceeding has already been extended due to the unsuccessful attempt by the parties to negotiate a settlement. Therefore, the brief extension requested here will have a very minimal effect on the time this matter has been pending. On the other hand, grant of the requested extension will serve

the public interest by allowing the Commission to have a complete record before ruling in this proceeding.




