Dear Ms. Dortch,

In response to a request from FCC Staff, Pay Tel Communications, Inc. (“Pay Tel”), through counsel, submits a revised Response to the Commission’s Mandatory Data Collection, which Pay Tel originally filed in this docket on August 18, 2014.

The only change that has been made to Pay Tel’s original Response is that common costs—which were previously reported only in aggregate—are now allocated to the prescribed categories of Telecom Costs, Equipment Costs, and Security Costs. No other changes were made to the Response. This modification to the reporting of common costs does not impact the overall conclusions of the Response, including results reported on a minutes-of-use basis. *See, e.g.,* Don J. Wood, Cost Analysis of Inmate Calling Services Provided by Pay Tel Communications, Inc., Prepared to Support the FCC’s 2014 Data Collection, at 1-2 (Aug. 18, 2014).

Pay Tel files these documents in redacted format via ECFS. An unredacted, proprietary version of this document is being filed under claim of confidentiality in compliance with the Instructions and the Protective Order entered December 19, 2013, in this docket (DA 13-2434).
