Re: *Applications of Charter Communications, Inc., Time Warner Cable Inc., and Advance/Newhouse Partnership for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Cable Television Relay Service Applications*, MB Docket No. 15-149<sup>1</sup>

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 31, 2015, Rick Dykhouse, Executive Vice President, General Counsel, and Corporate Secretary; Alex Hoehn-Saric, Senior Vice President, Government Affairs; and Sam Feder and the undersigned of Jenner and Block (collectively "Charter") spoke via conference call with the individuals copied below to discuss Charter's interconnection policies.

Charter explained that it offers two interconnection policies: (i) one under which it has committed to provide direct interconnection at no charge through 2018 for entities meeting certain criteria (mostly concerning size, security, and appropriate use of the interconnection),<sup>2</sup> and (ii) another long-standing policy that is available to typically smaller entities that may want a more flexible approach. Charter emphasized that it has provided free interconnection under the second policy as well, and plans to continue to do so, but that the second policy is more flexible in that it may be amended by Charter and allows a case-by-case approach by which the entities can establish a relationship that accommodates individual needs.

In response to questions, Charter clarified that a party seeking interconnection in Seattle need only deliver 3 Gbps of traffic to one of the two POPs in Seattle.
