The disparity of carriers using the allocated funds and the allocated bandwidths are greatest in rural areas, this where little or no service improvements are evident, yet rural areas are charge the same fees as areas having greater speed and service choices. Consideration by the FCC of a greater dispensation of bandwidth to carriers having rural connectivity and a penalty to carriers unable or unwilling to improve and/or expand such services to more rural areas and yet who still charge and take advantage of rural generated fees, and to expend rural fees generated in more profitable and less rural areas. Rural areas require the same or greater consideration by the FCC than more populated parts of this Nation.
