Region 5 voted to approve the attached changes to the Region plan to incorporate the new general use channels and the trunked deployable channels. Also the initial allocation of these channels is to Los Angeles County/LA-RICS for their new system. As their use will be well over 100 miles from the nearest border Region, this will not impact your region. There are new allotments to the city of Arcadia and Port of Los Angeles shown in the spreadsheet. Both are located in the County of Los Angeles and cover small areas.

Region 5 would like the trunked deployable channels to be available over the entire region and would ask you to either use those channels as trunked deployable or avoid allotting them in the areas near the Region 5 borders.
