Voice Services Comparability Report

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 54.313 (a) (10) Clay County Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. d/b/a Endeavor Communications ("Endeavor") is in compliance with the requirement that voice services is no more than two standard deviations above the national average urban rate for voice service of \$46.96 as specified in Public Notice DA 15-470 issued on April 16, 2015. For the exchanges of Atlanta, Coatesville, Mt. Meridian, Eminence, Reelsville, Cloverdale, Patricksburg, and Poland the current total local end-user rate¹ of \$17.26 (which includes a local fee of \$12.15, mandated state fees of \$5.00 for State SLC and \$.11 for State USF) and for the exchange of Monrovia the local end-user rate of \$23.01 (which includes a local fee of \$12.15, mandated state fees of \$5.00 for State SLC, \$0.11 for State USF and a Mandatory EAS service charge of \$5.75) are not above the standard deviation as specified in the USF/ICC Transformation Order.²
