On August 10, 2015, Hal Rosenberg, Senior Vice President of UP, Melissa Ingram, Senior Director of ASPIRE and Amy Mehlman of Mehlman Capitol Strategies met with Chanelle Hardy, Chief of Staff and Media Legal Adviser to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, concerning the above-referenced proceeding.

The discussion in this meeting focused upon the potential negative impacts of the contemplated acquisitions on independent programmers UP and ASPIRE. UP and ASPIRE expressed concerns that, if not adequately considered, the acquisitions could exacerbate a media landscape that suffers from a dearth of diversity, minority ownership and family-friendly programming.
