As the Station Manager of a new LPFM station in Fayetteville Arkansas I strongly concur with several of the rule changes proposed here.

An increase of power to up to 250 watts would be invaluable in penetrating buildings and assisting with coverage in our hilly terrain. We have emergency generator power at our location but how can this be useful when many in the community cannot receive our signal.

We MUST protect the existence of LPFM stations, serving their communities, but making them PRIMARY SERVICES.

While our station would not be interested in traditional commercials, underwriting rules must be clarified and eased, fund raising for third party non-profits allowed, and fines reduced.
