Re: Proposed Changes in the Commission’s Rules Regarding Human Exposure to Radiofrequency Electromagnetic Fields, ET Docket No. 03-137

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 12, 2015 Şadé Oshinubi and the undersigned of PCIA – The Wireless Infrastructure Association, Andy Lachance of Verizon, Collen Thompson, Robert Vitanza, and Celia Nogales of AT&T, Paul Roberts and Liz Hill of American Tower, Richard Engelman, Ray Rothermel, and Dave Kirk of Sprint, and Don Snyder of Crown Castle, together (“PCIA”), met with Bruce Romano, Ed Mantiplay, Martin Doczkat, and Neal McNeil of the Office of Engineering & Technology. Margaret Egler, Rebecca Dorch, and Jerry Ulcek of the Enforcement Bureau participated by telephone. In the meeting, PCIA discussed the Commission’s proposal to revise the Maximum Permissible Exposure-based exemption threshold criteria for fixed transmitter sites located on rooftops.¹

Consistent with previously filed comments, PCIA discussed the need for revised mitigation measures to retain flexibility and account for varied real-world siting conditions that exist today.² PCIA also discussed the challenges in establishing standard relationships with a variety of building owners and the transient workforce servicing the building’s structure and systems. PCIA also thanked the FCC for updating a consumer-centric RF exposure guide.³
