I see no problem with contour-shaping a radio signal to fully fill its license area as well as reducing interference between stations.

In my opinion, I would ask you to not change the rules, do not let radio become even more of an advertising jukebox with no personality nor excitement to it. Low power stations fill a local niche and they do it well. They serve the community interest whereas the large corporate stations do not. anymore.
