The purpose of my comments are to support the proposed power increase for LPFM licensees as well as the rule change allowing commercials to be sold as a way to support the facility.

Donations alone may not be enough to support the station and without these changes, it may not survive.

These changes will not harm commercial entities, as their rates and manpower are much greater than the LPFM.

Please make these small but important changes, allowing LPFM facilities to increase their power to 250 Watts and sell commercial advertising to the community it serves.
