JOINT MOTION TO REVISE SCHEDULING ORDER

Flat Wireless, LLC (“Flat”) and Cellco Partnership dba Verizon Wireless (“Verizon”) respectfully jointly request that the Commission revise the order adopted in this proceeding on July 15, 2015.¹ In that *Scheduling Order*, the Enforcement Bureau established filing dates consistent with a schedule agreed to by the parties. Since that time, however, Flat and Verizon have agreed to modify that schedule to facilitate the ability of both parties to brief the legal issues in this case and another case, *NTCH, Inc. v. Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless*, EB Docket No. 14-212, which raises the same legal issues and involves the same counsel and, in the case of Verizon, the same party. Accordingly, the parties jointly propose the following revisions to the *Scheduling Order*:
