As an amateur radio operator and hobbyist, I object to the idea of restricting access to software defined radio features in approved devices. There are many items available today for experimentation and for pressing into use for services like broadband hamnet, that will be locked down to amateur radio operators in most cases if this requirement is instituted. The hobbyist and amateur radio community is still infinitesimally small compared with the number of consumers in the market, so it is unlikely that manufacturers of things like wifi modules or routers will make separate experimental equipment available to radio amateurs for a reasonable price. Keeping in mind that virtually all the innovations referred to in the RM-11673 were made possible by hobbyists and radio amateurs.
