Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pine Tree Telephone, LLC (“Pine Tree”), an Otelco Inc. subsidiary, hereby requests access to confidential documents submitted in Docket No. 10-90 by Time Warner Cable, Inc. (“Time Warner”) on August 28, 2015, pertaining to the Commission’s 100 percent overlap preliminary determination. Time Warner is listed as an unsubsidized competitor in Pine Tree’s study area, and although Time Warner does not affirm itself as a service provider in all of the census blocks that it shares with Pine Tree, Time Warner nevertheless submitted confidential documents pertaining to its shared service area with Pine Tree. Pine Tree respectfully requests copies of these documents so that the Company can respond appropriately in this critical proceeding.


