

Clearwire provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules:

1. Name and Address of Carrier:

Clearwire Corporation

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance, Reduction, or Impairment: Clearwire plans to discontinue its provision of CPV effective November 6, 2015. Clearwire understands that this Application will be granted automatically on the 31st day after public notice of its filing, unless the Commission notifies Clearwire to the contrary.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected: Clearwire proposes to discontinue its provision of CPV in California, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, North Carolina, Oregon, Tennessee, and Texas.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected: CPV is a fixed VoIP service that enables business customers to place and receive voice telephone calls, as well as receive faxes, block certain incoming calls, and set up a company directory, over the wireless Internet connection provided by their CLEAR WiMAX service. The 2.5 GHz band spectrum that currently supports CLEAR WiMAX will be repurposed for major enhancements to Sprint's 4G LTE network, requiring CLEAR WiMAX to be discontinued.¹ Because Clearwire's provision of CPV is tied to CLEAR WiMAX, CPV will be discontinued as well. Features associated with CPV also will be

discontinued, such as Inbound Fax-to-Email, Interactive Voice Response and Company Directory, and Caller ID Blocking.


5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers: In accordance with Section 63.71(a), on September 9, 2015, Clearwire provided written notice, by first class mail, to its 20 affected CPV subscribers. Also on that date, Clearwire provided affected customers with the same notice via email. A sample copy of the notice that was mailed to customers is attached hereto as Attachment A.
6. Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-Dominant with Respect to the Service to be Discontinued, Reduced, or Impaired: Clearwire is considered non-dominant with respect to the affected service.

In accordance with Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, a copy of this Application is being mailed to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense and to the public utility commission and the Governor of each state in which the discontinuance of service is proposed.

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of CPV. The number of customers affected is small, and all customers have been given notice affording them ample time to acquire one of the many substitute services that are readily available to them. Clearwire, therefore, respectfully requests Commission approval of this Section 63.71 Application. Please direct any questions regarding this Application to the undersigned.

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING DISCONTINUANCE OF CLEAR PRO VOICE SERVICE

We sincerely thank you for being a loyal and valuable customer and for choosing CLEAR as your provider.

We don't like goodbyes, but unfortunately we need to remind you that your CLEAR Pro Voice service will end as of November 6, 2015 (12:01 AM EST). It's not just you - we are discontinuing CLEAR Pro Voice service in all states where we provide service.¹ CLEAR Pro Voice allows your business to place and receive voice telephone calls over the Internet connection provided by your CLEAR WiMAX service. Features associated with CLEAR Pro Voice, like Inbound Fax-to-Email, Interactive Voice Response and Company Directory, and Caller ID Blocking, will also end.

Your CLEAR Pro Voice service will be ending but you can get a comparable voice calling service from a variety of other providers operating in your area, including landline, VoIP, and wireless service providers. A quick Internet search for "voice service providers" in your city should give you some good options. If you plan to replace your CLEAR Pro Voice service, please do so by November 6, 2015, so that your service is not interrupted. If you are planning to transfer your phone number, please be sure to contact your intended provider to find out how much time it will take to process your transfer. If you choose not to migrate your service by November 6, 2015, your CLEAR Pro Voice account will be cancelled so that you will no longer be billed, and you may lose your CLEAR Pro Voice phone number after that date. You can contact us anytime if you would like to cancel your account earlier.

The good news is that you don't have to switch just yet! We'll continue to keep you updated in the coming months. We love having you as a customer while we still can. In the meantime, if you have any questions, please call us at 1-888-888-3113 and press any option to speak to one of our Care representatives.

CLEAR has notified the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") about this end of service. The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the FCC releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. You may file your comments electronically through the FCC's Electronic Comment Filing System using the docket number established in the FCC's public notice for this proceeding, or you may address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, 445 12th Street, SW, Washington, DC 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the § 63.71 Application of Clearwire Corporation. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.
