Decision on Appeal: **Denied**
Explanation:

- Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. sec. 1.1910(a)(1), USAC determined that you or an entity sharing the same Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) has been delinquent on the payment of a debt owed to the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) and/or the FCC. We issued a Notice of Withholding Action explaining the nature of the debt owed and the consequences of not satisfying the debt within 30 days of the date of the letter. USAC dismissed your application and denied all funding requests included in that application due to the fact that your debt had not been satisfied. In your appeal, you have not shown that USAC's determination was incorrect. Consequently, your appeal is denied.
