Dear Mr. Butler:


While I appreciate the FCC's interest in protection of radio-frequency emitter characteristics, this proposed blanket prohibition on third-party software in 5 GHz band WiFi routers appears to be a significant over-reach. I have been engaged in this industry since I became the youngest holder (at the time) of a First Class Operator's Permit, nearly 60 years ago.

I propose this item be rescheduled:

1. Because the comment period closes so soon after your announcement of the proposed action there is inadequate time to formulate a meaningful response.
2. Finally, that short response time is coincident with the removal of the FCC response site <http://apps.fcc.gov/ecfs/> (reported at <https://www.fcc.gov/blog/modernizing-fcc-s-it>), it looks suspiciously like the FCC is *intentionally* trying to impose a radical change without adequate citizen input.

May I suggest you ask the Commission to defer this item, and to re-advertise the agenda item with sufficient time to formulate reasoned and relevant responses from those of us actually active in the field?
