Dear Mr. Bryant:

You appealed from the action of the Executive Office for United States Attorneys (EOUSA) on your request for access to records concerning "granttors, grantees and vendors" associated with a variety of documents you attached to your request letter.

After carefully considering your appeal, I am affirming, on modified grounds, EOUSA's action on your request. A proper Freedom of Information Act request for records must reasonably describe the records sought. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(3)(A). Upon review of your correspondence, I have determined that you did not reasonably describe the subject of your request.

Please be advised that this Office's decision was made only after a full review of this matter. Your appeal was assigned to an attorney with this Office who thoroughly reviewed and analyzed your appeal, your underlying request, and the action of EOUSA in response to your request.

If you are dissatisfied with my action on your appeal, the FOIA permits you to file a lawsuit in federal district court in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(B).

For your information, the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) offers mediation services to resolve disputes between FOIA requesters and Federal agencies as a non-exclusive alternative to litigation. Using OGIS services does not affect your right to pursue litigation.
