The Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) of the United States Department of Justice received your requests for information, including one under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) on March 4, 2013. OVW administers federal grant programs authorized by the Violence Against Women Act and provides financial and technical assistance to communities around the country to facilitate the creation of programs, policies, and practices aimed at ending domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking. OVW does not possess the information that you are requesting.

This is the final action of the Office on Violence Against Women concerning your request. You may appeal this decision within 60 days from the date of this letter by writing to the Office of Information and Privacy, U.S. Department of Justice, Suite 11050, 1425 New York Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20530-0001. Both the envelope and the letter of appeal should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." If you appeal, and the decision is upheld, you may seek judicial review in the United States District Court for the judicial district in which you reside or have your principal place of business or in the District of Columbia.
