On September 21, 2015, the undersigned, accompanied by Andy Newton, Kelly McGriff, and William Hanes, of Southern Light, met with Commissioner O’Rielly, Amy Bender Gigi B. Sohn, Lisa Hone, Eric Feigenbaum, Rebekah Goodheart, Travis Litman, and Nicholas Degani Legal Advisor to Commissioner Pai. Southern Light discussed that it has been encountering difficulties with certain municipalities when deploying small cells or when offering broadband alternatives in certain municipalities. Small cells will continue to be an important tool in deploying wireless broadband services. Municipalities that prohibit their installation or otherwise impede deployment present important issues that the Commission may need to address in the near future. Additionally, municipalities that offer broadband services and then erect barriers to entry to competitive providers of such services may also require Commission action. The attached slides were distributed during our meetings.
