This is a letter of appeal for the RH Atlantic-Pacific BEN 16049970 in regards to the USAC Administrator's Decision on Appeal dated July 23, 2013.

An invoice deadline extension was requested on May 6, 2013 and denied on June 6, 2013 for the three applications. USAC's appeal decision cited that the request for the extension did not meet the conditions necessary to approve the appeal.

As you will see by the attached email chain, we have been working with the SLD invoicing department manager Mick Kraft for over two years regarding the invoicing of these applications.

When the applications were originally submitted, we responded to a High Cost Review, Selective Review and many additional review questions, all which led to a successful funding commitment. The work was completed and the Service Provider (Coastal Electric) used the SPI process for part of the invoicing. The rest of the project was paid in full by RH Atlantic-Pacific.

In order for RH Atlantic Pacific to receive the remainder of their reimbursements, **it is necessary to change the invoicing mode from SPI to BEAR**, as Coastal is no longer a viable company. I began contacting SLD Invoicing in February, 2011 in order to have the invoicing mode changed. That set off a complete re-review of the entire application to which we responded to the inquiries.

From February 2011 through May, 2013 I attempted to no avail to get the invoicing mode changed. Instead of that happening, I was either put off or ignored by Mick Kraft or asked additional review questions. Mick set up several conference calls with me but then didn't show up for the calls nor did he cancel them. When I escalated the review to Mel Blackwell he simply gave it back to Mick Kraft.



The last report (fluke report) requested by Mick Kraft would have resulted in RH Atlantic-Pacific having to spend over \$40,000 to obtain.

We would like to continue to pursue these funds, however without an invoicing deadline extension we can't. While the rules don't state that lackadaisical management at USAC is one of the approved conditions, I can't believe that the school should lose their funding because of that.

Please allow the deadline extensions, after which we can continue to pursue the change of invoicing mode so that RH Atlantic-Pacific can receive their reimbursements.

Hi Mel,

I'm hoping that you can help me with this – I've been trying to get an answer from Mick Kraft for more than 6 months but to no avail. (please see the email chain below)

RH Atlantic-Pacific had FRNs approved in 2009 to build a new school which is complete and fully functional. The service provider completed the e-rate portion of the project and used the SPIF method for part of the reimbursement. RH Atlantic also paid them directly for part of the project and wants to get reimbursed through e-rate using BEAR. There is currently legal action between RH Atlantic and the service provider (who may be filing for bankruptcy) – it's important that no money flows through them.

When this was brought to Mick's attention, the entire application seemed to be re-reviewed, despite the fact that we answered Selective Reviews, High Cost reviews and general review questions at the time of the application. Mick request a substantial amount of additional technical information, and we provided everything we could.

I don't understand why there continues to be a delay on this. The schools occupying the building are currently receiving e-rate funding for their services.

Can you do anything to expedite this situation? Mick rarely responds to my phone calls or emails and when he does it's only to tell me that there are more delays.
