Dear Secretary Dortch:

On April 29, 2014, the Federal Communications Commission conditionally granted Ysleta del Sur Pueblo a Low Power FM Broadcast Station Construction Permit. The permit expires 3:00 a.m. MDST on October 29, 2015. The permit was granted prior to the completion of the international notification process making the construction and operation on the station at the Pueblo's own risk and subject to modification, suspension or termination without right to hearing. The condition has not yet been removed.

The Pueblo, a federally recognized Indian tribe of limited means, has not been willing to proceed with construction or to expend other time, effort, and resources in constructing and operating the station until such time as the condition is removed. Even if the condition is removed today, or has been recently removed, not enough time remains in the initial time period to construct the facilities or otherwise comply with the permit.

The Pueblo remains committed to constructing a Low Power FM Broadcast Station. Pursuant to the provisions of 47 C.F.R. § 73.3598 the Pueblo respectfully requests that the expiration of the Construction Permit be tolled and that upon receipt of approval from Commission Federal de Telecommunications (COFETEL) that the construction period be extended for an additional 18 months.

Please advise whether this letter is not sufficient to properly request the tolling and/or the extension, or if it should be directed to another person.
