Dear Mr. Wheeler,

On behalf of the Regional Chamber of Commerce-San Gabriel Valley (RCCSGV), I am writing in support of the proposed merger between Time Warner Cable (TWC), Bright House Networks (BHN), and Charter Communications. The Regional Chamber serves the Southeast San Gabriel Valley and represents the communities of Diamond Bar, Walnut, La Puente, Rowland Heights, Hacienda Heights, and Valinda. RCCSGV is dedicated to providing advocacy, education, and networking resources for a better business and community environment.

We believe that the merger of these three companies will improve telecommunication performance and provide better service for subscribers. Charter offers a minimum broadband speed of 60 Mbps for less money than TWC or BHN with clear, uniform pricing across its service area. This broadband speed is available without any data caps, usage based pricing, modem or early termination fees. The newly merged corporation, New Charter, will offer this extremely fast broadband service to TWC and BHN customers regardless of location.

New Charter will also return Time Warner Cable call center jobs back to American Soil and will hire and train thousands of new employees for their customer service call centers and field technician operations. Most importantly, New Charter will remain committed to net neutrality and will not block or slow down internet traffic, engage in paid prioritization, and will not impose data caps or usage-based billing.
