On October 19, 2015, Reed Hundt, representing LightSquared, discussed by phone with Philip Verveer, counselor to the Chairman, the pending transfer of control applications. Mr. Hundt emphasized the need for prompt Commission action on the pending applications and the company's desire when New LightSquared emerges from bankruptcy to put its midband spectrum at work for the wireless industry and to meet rising consumer demand. The parties also reviewed the status of negotiations with the three GPS firms to resolve pending legal and spectrum claims.
