The principles of user choice and control are vitally important for a vibrant wireless ecosystem. But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I want to be able to update my own wireless software?not rely on slow manufacturers shipping updates.

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would make me feel less safe about the wireless networks I use and operate.

The draft rules also let the bandwidth service providers not do their jobs: my cable company, Mediacom, does not offer even a day-to-day report on how much data I have been using, unless I go in to check manually each day. This is unacceptable in this day and age!!! Mediacom can't even be conduced to offer such a service!!
