But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I want to be able to update my own wireless software?not rely on slow manufacturers shipping updates.

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would make me feel less safe about the wireless networks I use and operate.

I move my router to different counties, if this lock down is put into place I would be forced to by regionally locked routers, instead of using my custom firmware that detects which county I am in from surrounding wifi already being broadcast.
