
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Tuesday, October 27, 2015, James Arden Barnett, Jr. of this firm and Gerard J. Duffy of the Blooston law firm met on behalf of Sandwich Isles Communications, Inc. ("SIC") with Irene Flannery and Daniel J. Margolis of the Office of Native Affairs and Policy.

The topics of discussion were the telecommunications and public safety needs of the Hawaiian Home Lands and their native residents; the very high costs of serving the Hawaiian Home Lands; and the past and future role of SIC in serving the Hawaiian Home Lands. The particular focus was upon the critical importance of federal high-cost support in enabling SIC to operate its network and pay its outstanding loans, and the need and options for resumption of federal high-cost support for SIC.
