Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on October 27, 2015, Intelsat representatives Candice DeVane, Dick Evans and the undersigned met with Jose Albuquerque, Diane Garfield, Stephen Duall and Clay DeCell of the International Bureau to discuss the Commission's 10 Log N proposal in the above referenced rulemaking proceeding. The Intelsat representatives noted Intelsat's support of the SIA proposal to eliminate "N" from the gain and EIRP density masks. The Intelsat representatives argued that earth station applicants would lack sufficient information to know what value to use as "N". The Intelsat representatives further noted that any value provided to an earth station applicant by a satellite operator likely would overestimate the potential interference into the victim satellite, resulting in unnecessarily low EIRP density levels for the earth station.
