Dear Secretary:

Region 45 is submitting Appendix O: Plan Appendix to the Region 45 700 MHz Plan for FCC review and approval. This Plan Appendix addresses the FCC release of the former narrowband reserve channels (twenty four 12.5 kHz channels) for General Use.

Region 45 will be seeking letters of concurrence from the regions adjacent to Region 45, those being: Region 13 Illinois, Region 15 Iowa, Region 21 Michigan, Region 22 Minnesota, and Region 54 Chicago Metropolitan.

Region 45, the Wisconsin Region, is comprised of the entire State of Wisconsin with the exception of the following counties, which belong to Region 54: Dane, Dodge, Jefferson, Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Rock, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha. Region 45 contains sixty-one counties within the state of Wisconsin and a land area of 48,331 square miles.
