Dear Chairman Carrow:

This letter relates to the request of Regional Planning Committee 28 (700 MHz) to approve the Region's modified Plan as required by FCC 14-172. Pursuant to the action of the Commission in FCC 14-172, Regional Planning Committee 20 (700 MHz) adopted a motion at its May 20, 2015, meeting authorizing the Technical Committee to review the modified Plans of adjoining Regional Planning Committees and issue concurrences on behalf of the membership. Accordingly, the modified Plan of Region 28 was distributed to the Technical Committee for review and action as provided in 47 CFR §90.527(b) and approved by the Committee members. For the purpose of complying with the coordination requirement as found in 47 CFR §90.527(b), Region 20 is pleased to offer our concurrence as to the proposed modifications to the Region 28 Plan.

Region 20 does make one request to Region 28. We noted that Region 28 intends to use the former "reserve" channels within the Philadelphia "T-Band" area as identified in 47 CFR §90.303(b). Since the former "reserve" channel assignments will not be coordinated by CAPRAD and further, could be deployed up to 80 kilometers south of Philadelphia, Region 20 requests that any proposed allotments of these frequencies be coordinated with Region 20 as a precaution to preclude the potential of interference.

Thank you for sharing the modified Plan and Region 20 looks forward to working together to maximize the use of the 700 MHz frequency band.


