The California Public Utilities Commission is today separately submitting comments in response to the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC or Commission) above-captioned *Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPRM)* regarding the national transition of telecommunications networks. Specifically, key CPUC staff members were out of the office at critical points in the development of these comments. In addition, the CPUC unexpectedly has sustained a significant budget constraint that has demanded considerable attention and has required an internal redirection of resources.
