My name is Joshua Baker and I live in Madison, TN.

The principles of user choice and control are vitally important for a vibrant wireless ecosystem. But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I want to use my wireless router as a wireless access point, using it in reverse so I can connect many wired devices to my wifi

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would keep me from using my custom wireless configuration.

My DVR from Dish Network doesn't have a wireless option so it requires a LAN connection. Plugged into an old router using new firmware I am able to connect the DVR to my wireless network using the router in reverse.
