Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am filing this letter on behalf of Atlantic Broadband Finance, LLC, and its affiliates providing Interconnected VoIP services (collectively, "Atlantic Broadband"). In late August 2015, Atlantic Broadband for the first time exceeded 100,000 domestic retail subscriber lines.

Accordingly, I am filing this letter to report that Atlantic Broadband hands off its end-user customer calls to IDT Telecom, Inc. and its affiliated companies ("IDT"). Thus, IDT, and not Atlantic Broadband, makes the "initial long-distance call path decision" for Atlantic Broadband's voice customers. (Please note that IDT has previously included Atlantic Broadband's data in its reporting because of IDT's role as a "covered provider" under the Commission's rules.)
