
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Friday, October 30, 2015, James Arden Barnett, Jr. of this firm and Gerard J. Duffy of the Blooston law firm met on behalf of Sandwich Isles Communications, Inc. ("SIC") with Carol Matthey, Ryan Palmer and Garnet Hanly of the Wireline Competition Bureau regarding the status of high-cost support disbursements to SIC.

The topics of discussion included: (a) the telecommunications and public safety needs of the Hawaiian Home Lands and their native residents; (b) the very high costs of serving the Hawaiian Home Lands; (c) the past and future role of SIC in serving the Hawaiian Home Lands; (d) the importance of federal high-cost support in enabling SIC to operate its network and repay its outstanding loans; and (e) the need and options for resumption of federal high-cost support disbursements to SIC during various ongoing audits and investigations.
