The principles of user choice and control are vitally important for a vibrant wireless ecosystem. But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I want to be able to update my own wireless software?not rely on slow manufacturers shipping updates.

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would make me feel less safe about the wireless networks I use and operate.

Please keep this area of innovation open to the public domain! I've been in technology and software almost 20 years. Router vendors have no economic incentive to improve the software for devices models no longer sold. A community with no profit motive will make wireless routers more secure. All the wireless routers we use are purpose built using 3rd party open source software.
