But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I don't want to see community innovations, such as mesh networking, get cut off.

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would make me feel less safe about the wireless networks I use and operate.

It is an outrage to think that what we know of to be a open and free thing as the internet as we know it could be constricted by the views of the few who wish to control it.
