JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS FORMAL COMPLAINT

Complainant Frontier Communications of the Carolinas LLC (“Frontier”) and Respondent Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (“Duke”) jointly move for dismissal of the above-captioned formal complaint. In support, Frontier and Duke state as follows:

1. Frontier filed a Pole Attachment Complaint in the above-captioned proceeding on January 29, 2014 (“Complaint.”)
2. Frontier and Duke have settled the dispute giving rise to the Complaint. Accordingly, Frontier and Duke have agreed to seek dismissal of the Complaint as to all claims and defenses asserted therein, in order to dispose of all issues and controversies in the Complaint.
3. Under these circumstances, the parties respectfully submit that dismissal is both necessary and appropriate.
