On November 4, 2015, Stephanie Podey, Vice President and Associate General Counsel, and I, of the National Cable & Telecommunications Association (“NCTA”), had a phone conversation with Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff, Office of Commissioner Pai, regarding the above captioned proceeding.

We reiterated points discussed in NCTA’s comments and reply comments. In particular, the Commission’s audible guide rules already ensure that cable customers will receive information about accessible products and services. Thus, we explained that additional rules in this area are unfounded. We also discussed the need to maintain flexibility in examining whether to adopt any new rules regarding accessing captioning features and functions.
