Dear Ms. Dortch:

CenturyLink, on behalf of its incumbent local exchange carriers accepted 2012 Connect America Fund (CAF) Phase I Incremental Support (Round 1 Support) on July 24, 2012 and at that time submitted a list of locations to which it intended to deploy broadband service using that support.¹ Since that time, CenturyLink has made changes to those initial deployment plans. Thus, in accord with Commission rule 54.312(b)(3) CenturyLink is providing the attached list of census blocks for which we previously had identified locations to which we would deploy broadband service using Round 1 Support but for which we now know we will not be deploying broadband service using that support.

CenturyLink is also providing this information to the Universal Service Administrative Company, relevant state commissions, and affected Tribal governments, as appropriate.
