But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I want to be able to update my own wireless software?not rely on slow manufacturers shipping updates.

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would make me feel less safe about the wireless networks I use and operate.

Open source software enables me to use features like encryption, repeater mode, etc. which are not offered by manufacturer's software. Please don't regulate radio frequencies.
