**Re: Expanding the Economic and Innovation Opportunities of Spectrum through Incentive Auctions, GN Docket No. 12-268, AU Docket No. 14-252; Policies Regarding Mobile Spectrum Holdings, WT Docket No. 12-269**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 10, Philip Junker, John Bareham, and Tamara Preiss of Verizon spoke by telephone with Kate Matraves and Ben Freeman of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. We discussed the list of partial economic areas (PEAs) where the Bureau determined that Verizon is eligible to bid on reserved spectrum blocks in next year's 600 MHz auction.<sup>1</sup> Based on our review, we explained that PEAs 69 and 282 should be removed from the reserve-eligible list for Verizon. We also concluded that Verizon will be reserve-eligible in PEA 303 upon FCC approval of Verizon's lease of 700 MHz spectrum to Triangle Communication System, Inc.<sup>2</sup>
