Dear FCC,

My name is Adriano Garcia and I live in Mamaroneck, NY.

The principles of user choice and control are vitally important for a vibrant wireless ecosystem. But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I want to be able to update my own wireless software?not rely on slow manufacturers shipping updates.

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would make me feel less safe about the wireless networks I use and operate.

Being forced to use the manufacturer router firmware will expose me to a wide variety of security threats, as manufacturer firmware is very slow to update. In addition, older routers become unsupported once manufacturers no longer sell the device. These are all serious drawbacks to limiting open source and non-manufacturer firmware on routers.
