Re: SelecTel, Inc., Compass Atlantic Inc. and Compass Capital Incorporated; Joint Renewed Request for Extension of Domestic Special Temporary Authority to Operate Pending Approval of Application for Transfer of Control (WC Docket No. 15-8)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Authorized carrier SelecTel, Inc. (FRN 00184988352) ("SelecTel" or "Transferor") along with Compass Atlantic Inc. and Compass Capital Incorporated (collectively "Transferee") (Transferor and Transferee together the "Parties"), hereby request a renewed extension of the domestic Special Temporary Authority ("STA") originally granted by the Commission staff on May 29, 2015, and first extended by the Commission for sixty (60) days on September 10, 2015, for SelecTel to consummate a pending transaction prior to final FCC approval in order to allow SelecTel to continue to provide service to its end user customers pending Commission approval of the Parties' domestic joint section 214 applications for domestic and international transfer of control.

Renewed Request for Extension of Domestic STA; Good Cause

The Parties respectfully request a renewed extension of the Domestic STA. As outlined in the Parties' Request for Extension of Domestic STA, filed September 2, 2015, the Parties submit that good cause continues to exist for extending the Domestic STA on the basis that additional time is needed because the underlying Transfer of Control applications were removed from streamlined treatment by the Commission while the Executive Branch Agencies, participating in a working group informally known as "Team Telecom" (Department of Homeland Security, Department of Justice, including the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the Department of Defense), review the Transfer of Control Applications. That review remains ongoing and provides ample grounds for a grant of an extension at this time.

Background

A combined Joint Application for approval of the transfer of control was filed on December 12, 2014; however, the international application was withdrawn at SelecTel's request and the domestic application is currently pending before the Commission. A revised section 214 international application was filed on MyIBFS, Submission ID IB2015000960.

The Company was granted an international STA on May 29, 2015, which does not expire until November 25, 2015.

On June 19, 2015, the Parties consummated the transfer of control as disconnection of SelecTel's customers was imminent if SelecTel did not receive funding. Compass Capital Incorporated formed a new Delaware corporation, Compass Atlantic Inc., to acquire a majority of the stock of SelecTel. Pre-transaction, SelecTel had three shareholders: Teri O'Flaherty, Matthew O'Flaherty, and Stacy Hergenrader, each holding 33.33% of the stock of SelecTel. Compass Atlantic Inc. acquired all the stock of Teri O'Flaherty and Stacy Hergenrader, such that after the transaction, Compass Atlantic Inc. holds 66.67% of the stock and Matthew O'Flaherty owns 33.33% of the stock. SelecTel remains the certificated entity.

Based on the transfer of majority control to Transferee, the Parties filed the Transfer of Control Applications and the STA requests (which were promptly granted by Commission staff) in order to comply fully with the Commission's Rules. On September 2, 2015, the Parties requested an extension of the domestic STA, which the Commission subsequently granted on September 10, 2015, valid for sixty (60) days. The Parties now seek a renewed extension of the existing Domestic STA.

Conclusion

As in the case of the Commission's grant of SelecTel's initial extension request, grant of the instant, renewed Domestic STA extension request will serve the public interest as such grant will ensure no interruption of service, no inconvenience to customers, and no diminution in the availability of competitive local services. The transfer of control transaction was transparent and did not result in a reduction or impairment of service to SelecTel's customers. As a result of the transfer or control, SelecTel continues to have the technical, financial, and managerial capabilities to ensure the continuing provision of quality service to its customers.

The Parties acknowledge that grant of the requested Domestic STA renewed extension will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the Transfer of Control Applications and that, once granted, the STAs may be revoked on the Commission's own notice, without hearing. Applicants further acknowledge that grant of the requested STA extension and the Transfer of Control Applications will not preclude enforcement action.
