On November 12, 2015, Rick Chessen (Senior Vice President, Law & Regulatory Policy) and I met with Barbara Kreisman, Shaun Maher, Joyce Bernstein and Steven Broeckaert of the FCC's Media Bureau. We discussed NCTA's reply comments filed in the above-captioned proceeding regarding post-auction channel sharing by low power television stations.

In particular, we discussed the limited cable carriage rights granted to low power stations under the 1992 Cable Act and explained that the Spectrum Act did not expand those rights. We also discussed potential issues surrounding low power channel sharing, including post-auction channel sharing's potential impact on cable carriage.
