Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to discussions with Commission staff, Advance/Newhouse Partnership (the “Company”) hereby submits a Supplemental Response to the Commission’s “Information and Data Request to Advance/Newhouse Partnership,” dated September 21, 2015. In its initial Response to Request 62, the Company indicated that it did not have responsive data to complete Attachment F, because Bright House Networks (“BHN”) connects to Time Warner Cable’s (“TWC”) Internet backbone for the exchange of Internet traffic, and TWC provides BHN with interconnection services pursuant to BHN’s partnership arrangement with TWC.

Although TWC is responsible for all Internet traffic exchange for BHN, certain exchange points with third parties are located within BHN facilities, and BHN possesses associated utilization data not otherwise reported by TWC. Accordingly, relevant portions of Attachment F are now being submitted herewith based on utilization data provided by BHN and relationship and contractual information provided by TWC. (No revenue data is provided, as the Company understands that any such information would already have been included in TWC’s own Attachment F filing.)


