On November 17, 2015, Alexander Brown and Randy Brown of ONE World Sports (“OWS”) and the undersigned counsel for OWS met in an *ex parte* session with representatives of the FCC at the FCC headquarters in Washington, D.C. The FCC representatives present at the meeting were Elizabeth McIntyre, Bakari Middleton, James Bird, Julie Shulmer, Ty Bream, Bee Moradi, William Reed, Owen Kendler, Susan Singer, Elizabeth Cuttner, Ali Zayas, Mitali Shah, Chris Clark, Hillary DeNigro and Joel Rabinovitz. In addition, three other FCC representatives participated by telephone.

OWS stated its strong support for the proposed merger.¹ Specifically, OWS discussed how Charter has been an excellent supporter of OWS in all respects and has assisted in the growth of OWS’s service to minority ethnic groups. We additionally stated that Charter has imposed no material restrictions on OWS’s rights to license its content to national “over-the-top” providers or platforms.


