The principles of user choice and control are vitally important for a vibrant wireless ecosystem. But as written, the NPRM threatens to undermine these ideals by limiting what users can do with their devices. That's a concern, because I want to be able to update my own wireless software?not rely on slow manufacturers shipping updates.

The draft rules could enable device manufacturers to forbid third-party software, which would make me feel less safe about the wireless networks I use and operate.

Overly broad rules such as this will not be for the benefit of the individual or the small business owner, but rather stymie their ability to adapt their devices to suit their needs. Changes like this that simultaneously stifle innovation and freedom are not in the interest of the people and should be removed.
