Network Change:

Frontier will move Enhanced 911 functionality from the existing CML ECS1000 selective router in Gloversville to the TCS selective router also located in Gloversville. At this time Frontier needs to move the trunks to meet long-term capacity and growth requirements of interconnecting wireline, wireless, and VOIP carriers, as well as the needs of 911 customers. Additionally, the ESC 1000 has been Manufacturer Discontinued (MD) for some models and spare cards are getting scarce. Frontier will decommission the CML ECS-1000 selective router in this location following the scheduled migration.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

First, interconnecting carriers must issue an Access Service Request (ASR) to establish new SS7 connectivity to the appropriate TCS selective router. To prevent charges for the ASR's please insert the Project ID: NY-1238800, in the ASR block identified as "PROJECT". This action may require a physical relocation of the trunk facilities if applicable.

Next, interconnecting carriers must submit a second ASR to disconnect existing service from the CML ECS-1000 selective router, after the new trunks are established and converted.
