Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of TerraCom, Inc., and pursuant to section 64.1120(e)(2) of the Commission's Rules, we hereby notify the Commission of a change in the letter notification that was electronically filed in this docket on October 30, 2015. In that letter, we advised of a pending transfer of customers of YourTel America, Inc. ("YourTel") to TerraCom effective on or about November 30, 2015, pursuant to a merger of YourTel into TerraCom. The companies are currently commonly-owned affiliates. This is to advise that the referenced transaction will instead involve a simple reorganization of YourTel, wherein YourTel will remain a distinct legal and operating entity as a wholly owned subsidiary of TerraCom. YourTel will continue to be the service provider in the states it currently serves (Illinois, Kansas, Maine, Missouri, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Washington), operating as YourTel America, Inc. d/b/a TerraCom.

As described in the October 30 notification, there will be virtually no impact on customers because there will be no change in any customer's rates, service plan or terms of service. The only change to customers will be a change of YourTel's d/b/a name to TerraCom, of which all affected customers have been provided advance notice per the October 30 notification.
